Externally, the rear garden has been designed for low maintenance, featuring a combination of artificial grass and decking as well as rear access. Permit parking is available on-street.

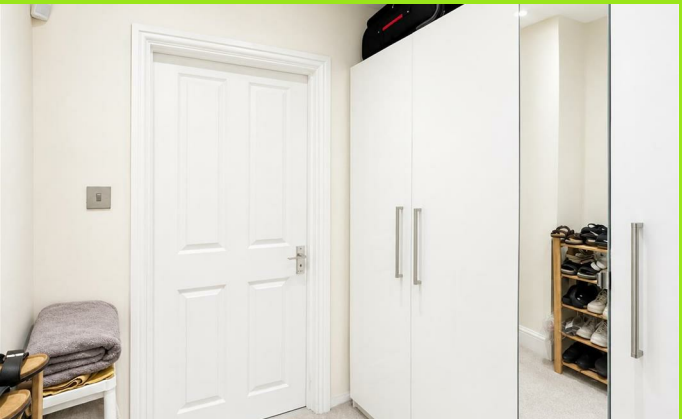
