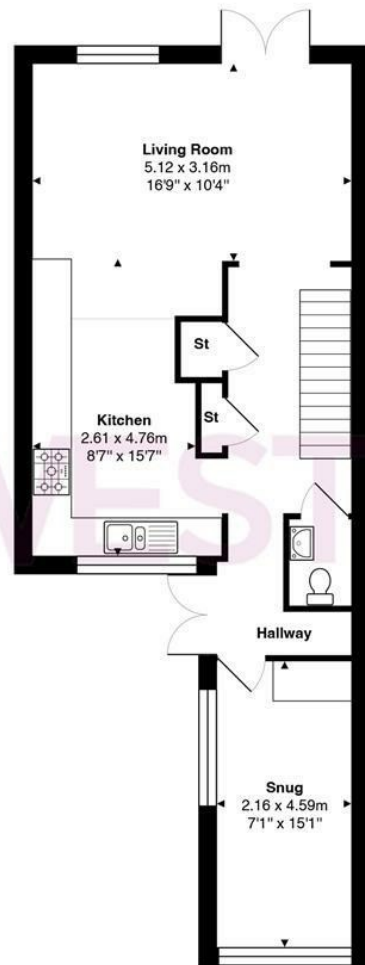

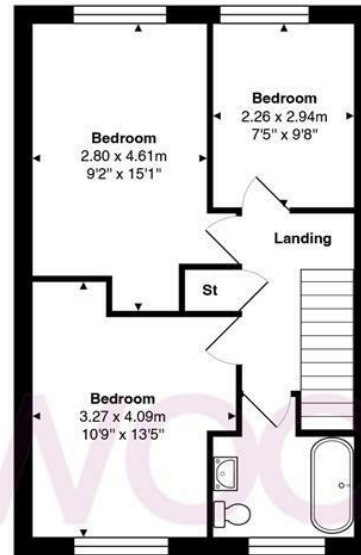

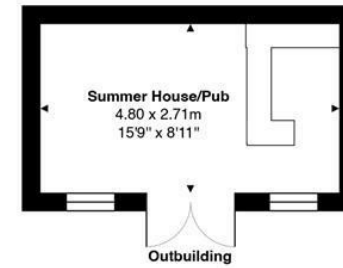




Ground Floor
