## **BEFORE YOU MOVE IN**

- **Security Deposit** an amount equivalent to one month's rent plus £100 is charged. This covers damages or defaults on the part of the tenant during the tenancy.
- **Holding Deposit** approximately one weeks' rent This is to reserve a property. Please Note: This will be withheld if any relevant person (including any guarantor(s)) withdraw from the tenancy, fail a Right- to Rent check, provide materially significant false or misleading information, or fail to sign their tenancy agreement (and / or Deed of Guarantee) within 15 calendar days (or other Deadline for Agreement as mutually agreed in writing).

## **DURING YOUR TENANCY**

- Unpaid Rent Interest of 3% above the bank of England Base Rate from Rent Due Date until paid in order to pursue non-payment of rent. Please Note: This will not be levied until the rent is more than 14 days in arrears
- Lost Key(s) or other Security Device(s) Tenants are liable to the actual cost of replacing any lost key(s) or other security device(s). If the loss results in locks needing to be changed, the actual costs of a locksmith, new lock and replacement keys for the tenant, landlord any other persons requiring keys will be charged to the tenant. If extra costs are incurred there will be a charge of £15 per hour (inc. VAT) for the time taken replacing lost key(s) or other security device(s).
- Change of Sharer (Tenant's Request) £75 (inc VAT) per replacement tenant or any reasonable costs incurred if higher. To cover the costs associated with taking landlord's instructions, new tenant referencing and Right-to-Rent checks, deposit registration as well as the preparation and execution of new legal documents.
- Variation of Contract (Tenant's Request) £75 (inc. VAT) per agreed variation. To cover the costs associated with taking landlord's instructions as well as the preparation and execution of new legal documents.

## TERMINATING YOUR TENANCY EARLY (SUBJECT TO CONSENT BEING PROVIDED BY YOUR LANDLORD)

• Should the Tenant wish to leave their contract early, they shall be liable to the landlord's costs in re-letting the property (typically one month's rent + VAT) as well as all the rent and bills due under the tenancy until the start date of the replacement tenancy. These cost however are unlikely to more than the outstanding rent.
